

# Extent of Works

Kaipara District Council are currently undertaking a number of planning projects that are aimed at improving the existing and future pedestrian and cycle connections in Mangawhai. With the growing population, subdivision, residential, commercial and industrial developments currently underway and being planned, there is an opportunity to provide a community that is well connected to both its cultural centers and its outstanding natural environment.

Molesworth Drive is the main arterial road that runs through Mangawhai. The existing pedestrian environment along Molesworth Drive varies from gravel path to sections of formed concrete footpath. It is proposed to provide a connected, integrated, safe and enjoyable shared path that extends from the Heather Street intersection in the north to the southern side of the Tara Creek bridge. Access to the shared path will be enhanced with the addition of two new pedestrian / cycle refuges along Molesworth Drive providing important connections between Mangawhai Community Park, surrounding residential areas and wider community.

This document has been prepared to assist in the design and consultation for the 1.5 km section of the Molesworth Drive shared path. It's purpose is to ensure that the shared path development provides connectivity with other proposed development initiatives including Mangawhai Central and the Coastal Walkway, provides a high level concept design outlining the proposed alignment of the shared path and how this alignment will interact with the existing and proposed site conditions, and how the works will be staged.
